To Whom It May Concern:

Superior Essex is an industry leader in making our cables “green.” In all of our operations, we have programs in place to reduce scrap and energy use, recycle materials and purchase items that are made from recycled materials.

For example, the cardboard boxes used for all of our category cables have at least 30% post-consumer fiber. The plastic reels onto which we put our cables have at least 90% recycled polymers. Both the boxes and the reels are recyclable as well.

We have a program in place with our wooden reel manufacture, where the end user sends the used wooden reel to our manufacturer, who then refurbishes and ships to us for our re-use.

Virtually all the scrap we generate from the manufacturing process is sent to recyclers, including all of the copper and nearly all of the plastics.

Most importantly, all of our copper telecom and datacom cables are RoHS compliant. This means that they do not contain heavy metals or toxic organic compounds that might affect ground water supply if any part of the product reached a landfill.

As the largest manufacturer of communications cable in North America, Superior Essex has built a solid reputation for performance, quality, customer support and environmental stewardship with many of the largest users of communications cables in the world.
